Parts Include:

Our pump comes equipped with a 1/2 inch nickel plated ball valve, a 1/2 inch sleeve and two barb connectors. All that's needed is 1/2 inch tubing. Push it onto the barb connector and you are ready to go.



Please read the manufactures instructions that come with this very fine pump. This pump will last a life time if used properly. We have used the March 809plhs in a RIMs system with much success. We have also found use in pumping hot water to the MiniBrew Hot Liquor Tank. You may consider using the pump to move wort from the kettle to the fermenter. The polysulphone will stand a temperature level of 400 degrees. We find it is best to turn off the boiling kettle and wait a few minutes for the wort to stop boiling before turning the pump on. You can inject clean oxygen into the outside line for aeration purposes. However, the oxygen T' into the line needs to be at least six feet back from the bottom valve on the fermenter. This insures the oxygen is throughly mixed with the wort before entering the fermenter. .
